What are cookies?

Cookies are small text file stored on your computer or mobile device when visiting our website. They don't usually contain any personal information on users so you cannot be identified by cookies

Why we use cookies

We use cookies to ensure that we give you the best experience on our website. Our website uses cookies, which could include also third party cookies, to send advertising that is relevant to you.

Types of cookie

There are different types of cookie, here are the ones we use and why:

Essential - These are typically used to help the site function correctly.

- Persistent cookies are stored by your browser with an expiry date but can be deleted by you before this.
- Session cookies expire at the end of a session, typically when you close your browser.

Performance – These are used to collect information about how our website is used.

- Analytics – to help us measure which pages and links are popular on our website and which ones are not. We use analytical cookies to help us work out trends and create a more user friendly solution
- Third party – Google analytics tracking uses cookies to track user experiences on our website and create reports on visitor activity. Google Analytics cookies do not collect personal data about website visitors, for more information, please see Google's privacy policy: <https://www.google.com/policies/privacy/>.

Advertising – These are typically used to identify and send you advertising and promotional material that may be relevant to you
